Education Park No. 17, Nanzhuang Seawall, Da'an Dist., Taichung City. Each year during the Hygrophila flowering season from October to February, the crown-shaped purple lowers bloom quite attractively. It is a very rare. endangered species. In addition to Hygrophila, there are also pygmy water lilies, yellow water lilies, etc. With butterflies flying, frogs croaking incessantly, and birds chirping, the park is a serene environment supporting rich ecological resources.

(4) Zero Egg (Lingdan) Platform

It was originally an important stop on the Dongfeng Railway and now is a small gathering ground for nearby vendors. It is called "Lingdai Platform" (meaning "retail stall" in Taiwanese) and often nicknamed "Zero Egg Platform because of its homonym with "retail stall"



⁽⁶⁾ Dongshi Forestry Culture Park

No. 1368, Sec. 6, Dongguan Rd., Dongshi Dist., Taichung City.

Opening hours: 06:00-18:00. Closed on Monday and Tuesdays. Formerly known as "Mount Daxue Forest Corporation," it was the largest lumber factory in East Asia in the 1960s. The Park still retains precious historical artifacts of the forestry industry and has been converted into an ecological conservation park in recent years.



(1) Tai'an Railway Culture Park

No. 52, Fuxing Rd., Houli Dist., Taichung City. Opening hours: 09:00-17:00.

The old Tai'an station has over 100 years of history. It became a railway cultural park after the old mountain line was suspended. It is the only station in Taiwan where the train platform is higher than the station building. Passengers must pass through a culvert to reach the platform.



(3) Lecheng Temple

No. 48, Hanxi St., East Dist., Taichung City. Opening hours: 06:30-22:00.

Built in the Qianlong period of the Qing dynasty, it is now a municipal historic building. The Hall of Yue Lao (God of Marriage and Love) is very popular. Come to feel the historical ambiance and ask Yue Lao to help you find love!



(5) Dali Art Plaza

(8) Wufeng Minsheng House of Microhistory No. 369, Zhongzheng Rd., Wufeng Dist., Taichung Cit TEL:(04)2339-1556

Opening hours: 09:00-17:00. Closed on Mondays. Formerly known as "Minsheng Clinic," in exhibits the history related to Wufeng and the lives of the local outstanding figures. It also holds farmers' markets, an "agricultural canteen" with great educational significance.



(10) Asia University Museum of Modern Art

half-moon pool and a green bamboo plantation, constituting a very pleasant scene

(3) Shekou Lin House (Dafudi)

Taichung City for the visit permi It is a siheyuan (Chinese quadrangle) with impressive structure. Its majesty is second only to the Wufeng Lin Family. The painted Koji pottery decoration in the house is quite famous. Together with Xiaoyun Villa and Zhaixing Villa, they are collectively called the three great mansions



(4) Zhanche(Tank) Park

No. 305, Yuexiang Rd., Daya Dist., Taichung City. The renovation is to be completed in May 2023.

Adiacent to the terminal of Tanva Shen Green Bikeway three M48A3 tanks which were the military weapons experiencing artillery fire and the chaos of war, are displayed here. The tanks were stationed at Ching Chuan Kang for decades before they were decommissioned and displayed here. Therefore the locals call this place the Zhanche (Tank) Park
