### ① Daan Coastal Amusement Park

Opening hours: 08:00-17:00. Closed on Tuesdays and in winter.  
Beach activities are open from March to October.  
Surfing and kiteboarding open from March to December.

Activities such as surfing and kiteboarding are available. It is the best place to cool off on hot summer days. The seaside luxury camping area "Nayang Beach" offers 38 camping tents to let you experience the fun of camping by the sea.



### ② Ta'an Hygrophila Ecological Education Park

Each year during the Hygrophila flowering season from October to February, the crown-shaped purple flowers bloom quite attractively. It is a very rare, endangered species. In addition to Hygrophila, there are also pygmy water lilies, yellow water lilies, etc. With butterflies flying, frogs croaking incessantly, and birds chirping, the park is a serene environment supporting rich ecological resources.



### ③ Wuqi Fisherman's Wharf

Known as the Mermaid Wharf, Wuqi Fisherman's Wharf focuses its development on production, recreation, and tourism. After enjoying seafood and buying sea products, you can take a sightseeing boat, and admire the 3D interactive murals that are vivid and lifelike, and good for taking some cute photos. It's definitely a perfect destination for family travel.

### ④ Gaomei Wetlands

Located on the south side of the Dajia River Estuary in Qingshui, Gaomei Wetlands have a rich and complex wetland ecosystem with both muddy and sandy beaches. It is also one of the few breeding areas for geese and ducks in Taiwan. Heading south to the Gaomei Wetlands Scenic Bridge, not only can you have a bird's-eye view of the entire Gaomei Wetlands, but also find a perfect place for bird watching and enjoying the sunset.



### ⑤ Taichung City Seaport Art Center

With a total area of three hectares, and the "courtyard space" as the overall interpretation of the space, the building is designed in southern Fujian Courtyard style with a traditional academy style. Simple and elegant, it's a multi-functional complex art exhibition venue.



### ⑦ Lishui Fishing Harbor

Besides boasting rich tidal ecology, there are also creatures such as small crabs, which can be seen at low tide. The Greek-style viewing platform, rebuilt from an old sea patrol station, has become a popular spot for wedding photography. It's a nice place for watching the sunset, enjoying the view of the sea, or riding a bicycle.



### ⑥ Wuqi Cultural Branch Office

This historic building is located in the very center of Wuqi Old Street, which is also a guesthouse. You can experience dressing in Yukata and tasting the Japanese meals. It is influencers' new favorite attraction on the coastline!



### ⑧ Huangxi Academy

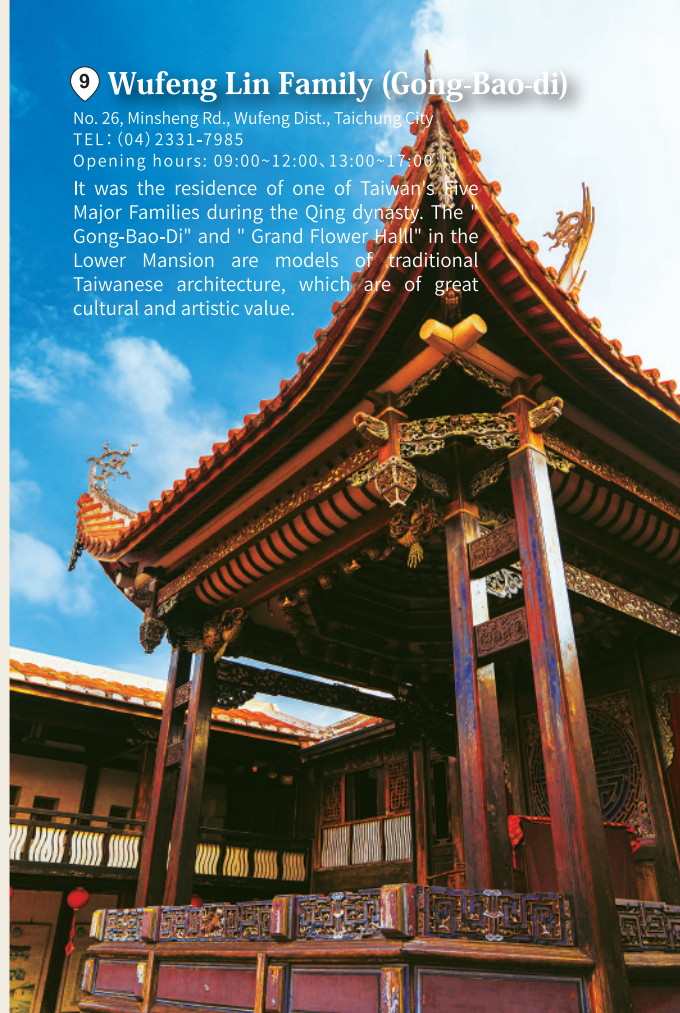

With over 130 years of history, exquisite brickwork and fine architecture, this historic site is regarded an outstanding work of cultural art and an educational building of the late Qing dynasty. It is the oldest building last in Dadu District.

### ⑨ Dajia Tiezhen Mountain Scenic Area

The themes of the scenic area are parent-child harmony, culture and history, natural attractions, and outdoor sports and camping. There are hiking trails, a sculpture park, Jianjing Square and playgrounds. In addition, you can ride your bike connecting from the Taiwan Cycling Route No.1 to the Challenger Bikeway on Chengong Road inside the scenic area.



### ⑨ Wufeng Lin Family (Gong-Bao-di)

It was the residence of one of Taiwan's five Major Families during the Qing dynasty. The Gong-Bao-Di and "Grand Flower Hall" in the Lower Mansion are models of traditional Taiwanese architecture, which are of great cultural and artistic value.



### ⑦ 921 Earthquake Museum of Taiwan

It was originally the campus of Guangfu Junior High School. After the 921 Earthquakes, the ruins were preserved to showcase the effect. It is a venue with commemorative and educational significance.



### ⑧ Wufeng Minsheng House of Microhistory

Opening hours: 09:00-17:00. Closed on Mondays.  
Formerly known as "Minsheng Clinic," it exhibits the history related to Wufeng and the lives of the local outstanding figures. It also holds farmers' markets, an "agricultural canteen" with great educational significance.



### ⑩ Asia University Museum of Modern Art

Design by Architect Tadao Ando, the equilateral triangle is adopted as the basic element. The space created with the crisscrossing arrangement become sculpture display and outdoor café seats.

### ⑪ Democratic Assembly Affairs Park, Legislative Yuan

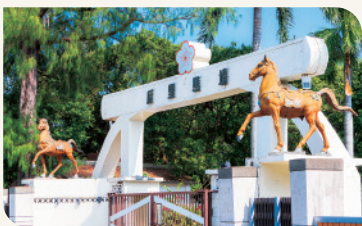

The entire Park is a historical symbol of Taiwan's democratic development, including Councilmen's Hall (Yili Hall), Democracy Lawn, Assembly Affairs Museum, etc., and it is a good place for people to relax and exercise.

## Bikeway Attractions



### ① Houli Horse Ranch

No. 41, Sishan Rd., Houli Dist., Taichung City.

Houli Horse Ranch is the most historic horse ranch in Taiwan, and also one of the venues in the 2018 Taichung World Flora Exposition. It still retains the buildings from the Japanese occupation period.



### ③ Hualiang Steel Bridge

Spanning the Dajia River, it used to be an important bridge for the old Mountain Line of the Western Trunk railway. Looking from a distance, it has a majestic and graceful appearance. After the railway was suspended, it was transformed into a very distinctive bikeway.



### ⑤ Dongshi Hakka Cultural Park

No. 1, Zhongshan Rd., Dongshi Dist., Taichung City.

Opening hours: 09:00-17:00. Closed on Monday.

Reconstructed from the old Dongshi Railway Station, the waiting room is converted into a showroom, exhibiting the long benches from the old train station and the Hakka artifacts.



### ② Tunnel No. 9

It is part of the old mountain train line tunnel, with a total length of 1.2 kilometers and a century-old history. Riding a bicycle into the tunnel entrance is like travelling into a time tunnel.



### ④ Zero Egg (Lingdan) Platform

It was originally an important stop on the Dongfeng Railway and now is a small gathering ground for nearby vendors. It is called "Lingdan Platform" (meaning "retail stall" in Taiwanese) and often nicknamed "Zero Egg Platform" because of its homonym with "retail stall".



### ⑥ Dongshi Forestry Culture Park

Opening hours: 06:00-18:00. Closed on Monday and Tuesdays.

Formerly known as "Mount Daxue Forest Corporation," it was the largest lumber factory in East Asia in the 1960s. The Park still retains precious historical artifacts of the forestry industry and has been converted into an ecological conservation park in recent years.

### ① Tai'an Railway Culture Park

No. 52, Fuxing Rd., Houti Dist., Taichung City.  
Opening hours: 09:00-17:00.

The old Tai'an station has over 100 years of history. It became a railway cultural park after the old mountain line was suspended. It is the only station in Taiwan where the train platform is higher than the station building. Passengers must pass through a culvert to reach the platform.



### ③ Lecheng Temple

No. 48, Hanxi St., Houti Dist., Taichung City.

Built in the Qianlong period of the Qing dynasty, it is now a municipal historic building. The Hall of Yue Lao (God of Marriage and Love) is very popular. Come to feel the historical ambience and ask Yue Lao to help you find love!



### ⑤ Dali Art Plaza

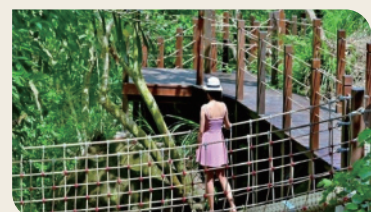
Located in the Taichung Software Park, it sells food and beverages, souvenirs, and it has an art gallery with many eye-catching art installations, which is widely loved by art enthusiasts and tourists.



### ② Miao Dong Night Market

There was originally a group of food vendors next to Ciji Temple. After the Temple's expansion, this shopping district has formed and become a major choice for the locals. There are many famous street foods that attract tourists.



### ④ Taiping Bat Cave Hiking Trail

The hiking trail has a total length of 1.3 kilometers. There is a rich natural ecology all along the way, where visitors can overlook the valley of clear waters and a unique canyon and deep pool formed by sprawling exposed rocks.



### ⑥ Guangfu New Village

The first new town in Taiwan built under the concept of "Garden City" in the early days. It has been transformed into a cultural-creative cluster that gathered indie designers and their works. Various installation artworks and art studios can be found in the streets and alleys.
